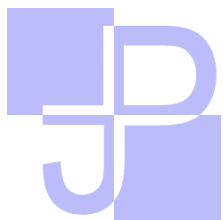

## When to test? Recommended SCHEDULE (in non-Biblical-plague years)

## What's the deal with Test Optional schools?

Some schools (UCs, CSUs) are currently **TEST BLIND**. No need for SAT/ACT here.

Some schools (mostly East Coast and Southern schools so far) are **REQUIRING SAT/ACT** again.

Most schools remain **TEST OPTIONAL**. Use the SAT/ACT here if it helps you.

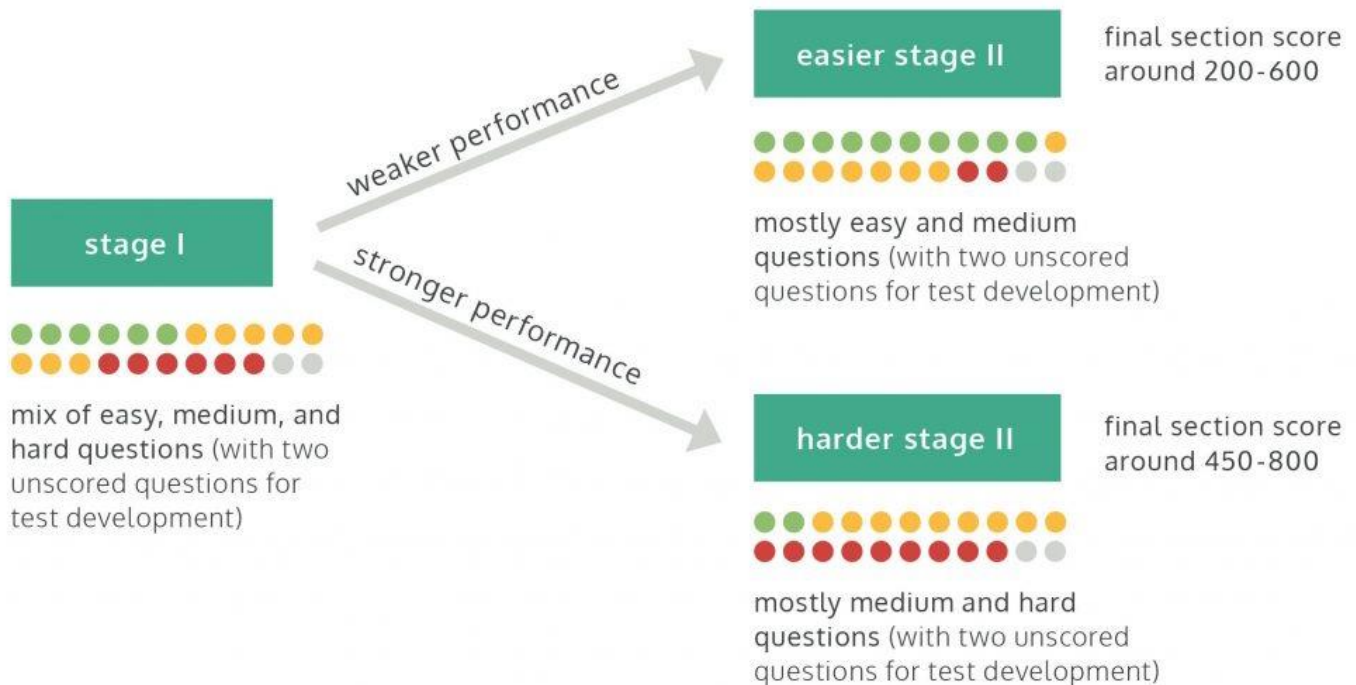

### WHAT'S NEW?

- Shorter reading passages + a few vocab questions (otherwise content is the same as previous versions)
- Fully digital – you'll need a laptop, Chromebook or iPad for the test, with the SAT Bluebook App downloaded and a College Board account created. Scratch paper OK.
- Graphing Calculator (Desmos) allowed for all Math questions (+ built right into the App)
- Shorter... and adaptive! Performance on Module 1 stage determines how hard Module 2 stage will be (but also your score range)!



Juniors: Consider trying BOTH the paper (Oct, Nov, Dec) AND digital formats, to see which one you score higher on!

## **REASONS TO TAKE THE SAT/ACT**

- You probably don't know where you're applying yet/who will require.
- Your PSAT score is not your final SAT score
- It's a tough world out there for GPA-only apps.
- Do it for the \$\$\$! (scholarships, but also out of state schools competing with UCs for price)
- Higher acceptance rates for those with score.
- No downside (except a Saturday morning) – You can always take and NOT submit your scores.


## **REASONS TO NOT TAKE THE SAT/ACT**

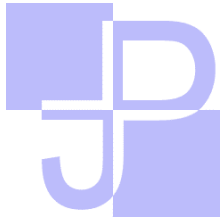
- Your GPA is one of the top in the class and your PSAT is very low
- You're only applying to UCs/CSUs

## How do I raise my score?

### QUICK TIPS

- 1) No penalty for guessing! So **GUESS ON EVERY QUESTION**... but that doesn't mean you actually have to DO every question. Skip (guess quickly on) some to get more right.
- 2) There's no "MOST correct answer"... there's **one RIGHT answer, and three/four WRONG answers**. Sometimes it's better to think less about which ones are right, and more about which ones are wrong.
- 3) Improvement has three parts: **A) DO PRACTICE QUESTIONS. B) REVIEW YOUR MISTAKES. And C) LEARN FROM THESE MISTAKES**, whether it's a math concept you didn't know, a grammar rule you didn't spot, or a wrong answer type you didn't notice. **YOU WILL SEE THE SAME BASIC QUESTIONS AGAIN** - that's what a STANDARDIZED test means.
